

## Terms & Conditions of Epilepsy New Zealand Membership

These terms and conditions form your membership with The Epilepsy Association of New Zealand Incorporated.

### **Definitions**

1. Epilepsy New Zealand (ENZ) means Epilepsy Association of New Zealand Incorporated  
'Membership' means Epilepsy New Zealand Membership  
'Membership Benefits' means Epilepsy New Zealand membership benefits, including membership discounts, services and products offered to you from time to time  
'Membership Card' means any official Epilepsy New Zealand membership card issued to you at any time  
'we', 'our' or 'us' means Epilepsy Association of New Zealand Incorporated  
'our website' means the Epilepsy Association of New Zealand Incorporated internet site located at [www.epilepsy.org.nz](http://www.epilepsy.org.nz)

### **Start of Membership**

2. Your membership will commence when you receive your notification of acceptance of your membership application.

### **Membership Validity**

3. The Epilepsy New Zealand Membership year runs from 1 April to 31 March.

### **Termination of Your Membership**

4. You may terminate your membership with immediate effect by giving us notice in writing at any time.
5. No refund of your membership fee or any part thereof will be made in any case of termination of your membership.
6. We may terminate your membership with immediate effect in accordance with the provisions relating to this in the Epilepsy Association of New Zealand Incorporated Constitution.

### **Membership Benefits**

7. All membership benefits that may be offered to you from time to time will be provided on a discretionary basis and may be revised, suspended or withdrawn by us at any time.
8. All offers of membership benefits shall be subject to these terms, any other rules or terms that may apply to any specific membership benefits and any user guides or other instructions given to you. The rules or terms of any specific membership benefits will prevail over the general terms in the event of any conflict.

### **Your Personal Information**

9. We, our employees, may use any personal information you provide solely for the benefit of Epilepsy New Zealand. We do not disclose your personal data to our subsidiaries or other organisations
10. You must keep your address or any other personal information up to date through our website through the contact us facility. Otherwise in writing to the address above.

### **Other Rules**

11. It is a condition of your membership that you abide by The Epilepsy Association of New Zealand Constitution and rules.
12. By applying for membership, you acknowledge that The Epilepsy Association of New Zealand is the governing body in New Zealand for Epilepsy New Zealand and its Branches including services, employees and volunteers.

### **Liability**

13. We warrant that the membership services we provide will be provided using reasonable care and skill. We do not warrant that the services will be uninterrupted or error free, and give no other warranty, guarantee or representation as to the performance of any of the same.
14. Nothing in these terms will affect your statutory rights as a consumer.

### **Changes to these Terms**

15. We may make additions or changes to these terms on the giving of reasonable notice, where we reasonably consider it necessary to do so. If the addition or change is to your detriment, you may, within 21 days of us giving you notice of the addition or change, terminate your membership under clause 9.

### **General**

16. We may provide any membership benefit to you through any agent or sub-contractor appointed by us in our absolute discretion.
17. Nothing in these terms shall give any rights to any person other than you.
18. These terms shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of New Zealand and be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the New Zealand courts.
