TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Thank you for supporting Epilepsy NZ. We're grateful for every community fundraiser that helps us support people living with epilepsy across Aotearoa New Zealand.

Before you get started, here are a few important things to be aware of:

- Get approval first: Please don't use Epilepsy NZ's name, logo, or branding unless we've approved your fundraiser.
- Fundraise independently: You're fundraising in support of Epilepsy NZ, not on our behalf. This means you can't make commitments, promises, or agreements for us.
- Be respectful and safe: Fundraisers should be lawful, honest, inclusive, and safe for everyone involved.
- Look after our reputation: Please make sure your activity reflects positively on Epilepsy NZ and the people we support.
- Be clear and transparent: Let people know how their donations will support Epilepsy NZ.
- Handle funds responsibly: Please send all funds raised to Epilepsy NZ within 7 days of finishing your fundraiser.
- Check before approaching sponsors or media: If you'd like to contact businesses, media, or trusts connected with Epilepsy NZ, please check with us first.
- Use our materials properly: Any Epilepsy NZ materials provided must only be used for your approved fundraiser and not altered.
- We may step in if needed: If something isn't working or doesn't align with our values, we may ask for changes or for the activity to stop.

By checking this box, you agree to the following terms and conditions:

AUTHORITY AND USE OF NAME

1. You must not fundraise or carry out any activity using Epilepsy NZ's name, logo, or other imagery unless you have received prior approval from Epilepsy NZ.
2. You are not authorised to represent Epilepsy NZ, speak on its behalf, or enter into any agreement or contract that binds Epilepsy NZ.

FUNDRAISING CONDUCT AND COMPLIANCE



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3. You agree to conduct all fundraising activities in a lawful, ethical, and transparent manner, and to comply with all relevant New Zealand laws, regulations, permits, and local council requirements.

4. You are responsible for ensuring the safety and wellbeing of all participants and attendees, including appropriate risk management and health and safety practices.

5. You must not approach any corporate supporter, media organisation, or charitable trust connected with Epilepsy NZ without prior approval from the Fundraising & Marketing Manager (marketing@epilepsy.org.nz).

FINANCIAL ACCOUNTABILITY

6. All funds raised for Epilepsy NZ must be paid in full to Epilepsy NZ within seven (7) days of the completion of the fundraising activity, using the bank details provided.

7. Funds must not be used to cover personal expenses unless expressly approved by Epilepsy NZ in advance.

8. You agree to keep accurate records of funds raised and, if requested, provide a summary of income and expenses relating to the fundraiser.

REPUTATION, COMMUNICATIONS & MATERIALS

9. You acknowledge that Epilepsy NZ's reputation and public trust are essential to its charitable purpose and agree not to engage in any activity that may damage or bring the organisation into disrepute.

10. Any promotional materials provided by Epilepsy NZ may only be used for the approved fundraiser and must not be altered, defaced, or reused for other purposes without consent.

11. Epilepsy NZ reserves the right to require changes to, or ending of, any fundraising activity that does not align with these terms or its values.

AUTHORITY TO AGREE

12. By agreeing to these terms, you confirm that you are authorised to do so and will carry out these obligations on behalf of yourself or your organisation, where applicable.



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
